The Alabama Rivers Alliance has facilitated the growth and success of the Water Protection Movement in Alabama since 1996.

As local watershed groups began forming in the mid 1980's they began to realize that many of the issues they faced were linked to weak environmental policies at the state level, and that to improve Alabama's protection of water resources would require both a larger movement and a statewide organization serving as the hub. Many years later the Alabama Rivers Alliance was born.

In just five years, the Alabama Rivers Alliance has more than tripled the number of local watershed groups in the state, won two Clean Water Act lawsuits, improved countless pollution permits and policies, become an effective presence in the state legislature and spread an awareness of watershed issues to thousands.
